

Nuclear Security Personal Development Grants

Are you a Researcher working in Nuclear Security Science at a University, Research Establishment or a Company within the UK?

Are you struggling to find funding to attend a Nuclear Security related Research Conference, Training Course or an Industrial Placement within or outside of the UK?

Will your proposed activities strengthen your research and innovation capacity or enable new collaborations in Nuclear Security Science?

If you have answered YES, to all 3 questions then you may be eligible to receive a Personal Development Grant of up to £1,000 from the STFC Nuclear Security Science Network+.

To date we have made 16 Awards totalling > £17,000. The awards have helped Early Career Researchers to support attendance and collaborations at Nuclear Security Science events and courses in Europe, the USA and Australia.

We will consider applications twice a year. The closing date for applications will be **31st August** and **28th February** each year up to 2022. Applicants will be informed of a decision usually within 2-4 weeks of submission.
